

Statute of the "InterSlavic Language Forum" Foundation

Chapter I. General Provisions

§ 1

1. The Foundation "InterSlavic Language Forum", hereinafter referred to as the Foundation, operates under the Act of April 6, 1984, on Foundations and the provisions of this statute.
2. The Foundation was established by Michał Swat, ID number AZA 684388, hereinafter referred to as the Founder, by a notarial deed drawn up by notary Jakub Szymczak at the Notarial Office of Jakub Szymczak in Poznań, Gronowa Street 22, Suite 1202, 61-655 Poznań, on January 31, 2024.

§ 2

1. The registered office of the Foundation is Poznań.
2. The Foundation's duration is indefinite.
3. The area of operation of the Foundation is the entire territory of the Republic of Poland. However, in order to properly achieve its objectives, the Foundation may also operate outside the borders of the Republic of Poland.

§ 3

1. The Foundation has legal personality.
2. The Foundation is supervised by the minister competent for culture and national heritage.

§ 4

The Foundation may establish certificates, badges, and award them, along with other prizes and distinctions, to individuals and legal entities who have contributed to the Foundation or who have supported the achievement of its objectives.

Chapter II. Goals and Principles of Operation of the Foundation

§ 5

1. The goal of the Foundation is research and educational-cultural activities, particularly in the field of Slavic languages, including work with the Interslavic language and its variants.
2. The Foundation's goals may only be changed with the consent of the Founder, or, after his death, with the consent of the Foundation's Council and Board.

§ 6

1. The Foundation achieves its goals through:
 - a. cultural, research, and educational activities concerning Slavic languages and the InterSlavic language, and supporting such activities,
 - b. promoting the InterSlavic language or its variants and Slavic languages in the country and abroad,
 - c. organizing and participating in events, conferences, symposia, and similar events related to linguistic, scientific, and cultural topics,
 - d. organizing concerts, performances, exhibitions, vernissages where the InterSlavic language is used or promoted,
 - e. digitization of resources and creation of electronic databases of literature and materials, as well as similar items in Slavic languages,
 - f. promoting the learning of Slavic languages, the InterSlavic language, or its variants, and facilitating the learning of languages,
 - g. conducting publishing activities in connection with the achievement of statutory goals,
 - h. working on the standardization, analysis, and development of the lexicon, spelling, and grammar of the InterSlavic language, continuing the tradition of the InterSlavic Committee (Medžuslovjanska Komisija, InterSlavic Committee),
 - i. creating, publishing, and collecting materials for learning the InterSlavic language, literature, and other types of cultural materials and artifacts related to the InterSlavic language or its variants,
 - j. cooperating with universities, schools, professional organizations, cultural institutions, and other organizations in the country and abroad engaged in similar or the same activities,
 - k. conducting workshops and training for teachers of Slavic languages aimed at improving the quality of education, promoting modern language learning methods, and enhancing language flexibility,
 - l. establishing cooperation with universities and research institutes to conduct joint research projects,
 - m. promoting and creating culture and art in Slavic languages and the InterSlavic language or its variants,
 - n. cooperating with other foundations in partnerships and associations,
 - o. developing international cooperation and collaboration between the countries of the European Union,
 - p. working for cultural dialogue, cultural exchange, and integration between countries and residents of the region and the European Union,
 - q. organizing competitions and awards related to Slavic and InterSlavic language topics.

§ 7

1. The Foundation may conduct economic activities to the extent necessary for achieving its goals, in accordance with applicable laws and this Statute.
2. The Foundation may engage in economic activities in the country and abroad, in accordance with applicable laws, in the following areas:
 - a. Supporting educational activities (PKD 85.60.Z) – primary activity,
 - b. Service activities related to print preparation (PKD 18.13.Z),

- c. Retail sales conducted via mail order houses or the Internet (PKD 47.91.Z),
- d. Other retail sales conducted outside of stores, stalls, and markets (PKD 47.99.Z),
- e. Publishing books (PKD 58.11.Z),
- f. Publishing magazines and other periodicals (PKD 58.14.Z),
- g. Other publishing activities (PKD 58.19.Z),
- h. Publishing in the field of other software (PKD 58.29.Z),
- i. Activities related to the production of films, video recordings, and television programs (PKD 59.11.Z),
- j. Software-related activities (PKD 62.01.Z),
- k. Data processing, website management (hosting), and similar activities (PKD 63.11.Z),
- l. Internet portal activities (PKD 63.12.Z),
- m. Other information service activities not elsewhere classified (PKD 69.99.Z),
- n. Rental and management of owned or leased real estate (PKD 68.20.Z),
- o. Other professional, scientific, and technical activities not elsewhere classified (PKD 74.90.Z),
- p. Activities related to the organization of fairs, exhibitions, and congresses (PKD 82.30.Z),
- q. Other support activities for business operations, not elsewhere classified (PKD 82.99.Z),
- r. Other out-of-school education forms not elsewhere classified (PKD 85.59.B),
- s. Activities of professional organizations (PKD 94.12.Z),
- t. Activities of other membership organizations not elsewhere classified (PKD 94.99.Z).

Chapter III. Assets and Income of the Foundation

§ 8

1. The assets of the Foundation consist of the founding fund in the amount of 2,100 PLN (two thousand one hundred zlotys), of which 1,000 PLN is allocated for economic activities, and 1,100 PLN for statutory and statutory-paid activities, and other property acquired by the Foundation during its operations.
2. The assets of the Foundation, apart from the founding fund, may consist of financial resources, real estate, movable property, and other assets acquired by the Foundation during its operations.

§ 9

1. The income of the Foundation comes from:
 - a. donations, inheritances, legacies,
 - b. subsidies and subventions from legal entities,
 - c. public collections,
 - d. programs for patrons and donors, and project adoption,
 - e. the Foundation's assets,
 - f. obtaining funds from international organizations interested in the Foundation's statutory activities,

- g. sales of products related to the Foundation's goals,
 - h. interest and bank deposits,
 - i. cooperation with academic and research institutions,
 - j. partnerships with businesses interested in the Foundation's statutory activities and support from them,
 - k. scientific grants,
 - l. paid services,
 - m. organizing events such as festivals, concerts, exhibitions, etc.
2. All income obtained by the Foundation is allocated to statutory, statutory-paid, and economic activities.

Chapter IV. Authorities of the Foundation

§ 10

The authorities of the Foundation are:

- a. The Board of the Foundation, hereinafter referred to as the Board,
- b. The Council of the Foundation, hereinafter referred to as the Council,
- c. The Founder of the Foundation.
